CHETHAM'S LIBRARY IN MANCHESTER, ENGLAND, IS THE OLDEST FREE PUBLIC REFERENCE LIBRARY IN THE UNITED KINGDOM. IT HAS BEEN IN CONTINUOUS USE SINCE 1653 AND HOLDS MORE THAN 100,000 VOLUMES OF PRINTED BOOKS, OF WHICH 60,000 WERE PUBLISHED BEFORE 1851. CHETHAM'S WAS THE MEETING PLACE OF KARL MARX AND FRIEDRICH ENGELS WHEN MARX VISITED MANCHESTER.
